Why a graduate degree in music therapy?

"There are many reasons why individuals pursue a master's degree in music therapy, even though it is not a requirement for certification. The literature suggests master's-level music therapists have better job satisfaction (Braswell, Decuir, & Jacobs, 1989; Cohen & Behrens, 2002) and stay in the field longer (Cohen & Behrens, 2002; Vega, 2010)" (Iwamasa, 2019, p.203 (<https://academic.oup.com/mtp/article/37/2/196/5521843/>)).
