

SUBSTANCE ABUSE COUNSELING CERTIFICATE

The certificate program is a flexible option for people who already have a degree in social work, allowing them to earn certification in a specialized, in-demand field with as little as seven credits of additional classwork.

Requirements

For alumni who have previously completed a Social Work degree and have taken SW-200, SW-250, SW-300 and SW-400, only the remaining seven credits will be required.
